



WASTE SEPARATION

What goes in which bin?

Grey bin	Residual waste and packaging without the "Green Dot"
Yellow bin	Packaging with the "Green Dot" (metals, plastics, composites), clean and without contents (scraped clean, not rinsed) Not allowed in the yellow bin: paper, cardboard, glass and plastic products such as buckets or laundry baskets.
Blue bin or waste paper container	Paper, cardboard and cardboard packaging that is not soiled or coated. Not allowed: tissues, paper plates, beverage cartons, photos.
Organic waste bin	Biological waste (e.g. grass clippings, flowers, fruit waste, coffee grounds) Not allowed in the organic waste bin: stones, coal ash, topsoil, faeces.
Glass recycling bin	Disposable glass packaging, separated into white, brown and green glass. Not allowed: window glass, mirrors, porcelain, light bulbs.

What is collected separately on request?

Bulky waste	Bulky items that do not fit into official rubbish bags (e.g. furniture, mattresses and carpets). Not allowed in the bulky waste: waste in bags and cardboard boxes, building materials and components, garden waste, and car or motorcycle parts.
Electrical waste	Electrical appliances without a drive motor (e.g. household appliances, telephones, consumer electronics, computers, printers). Not allowed in electrical waste: toner cartridges, batteries, and rechargeable batteries.
Pruning and leaf waste	Branches and shrub cuttings, no longer than 150 cm and bundled by hand, as well as tree trunks (up to 150 cm in length and 15 cm in diameter). Not collected: root balls and material filled into bags. Exception: During the autumn leaf season, from mid-September to the end of November, neutral (not yellow!) bags filled exclusively with leaves are also collected on the grey bin collection days.
